FAMILIES WITH 2 OR MORE STUDENTS REGISTERED: The second sibling discount is \$300 off the yearly tuition. The discount is deducted from the second child’s last tuition payment in April, 2018.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: The **non-refundable** Registration Fee is due upon enrollment. **The first tuition payment is due by May 5, 2018. This payment is not refundable after June 1, 2018.** Monthly tuition payments are due **on or before the fifth** day of each month from August, 2018 through April, 2019. A **\$10.00 late fee** is charged after the **tenth** of the month.

PAYMENT PLANS: You may choose the 10 month payment plan: May, 2018 and August, 2018 to April, 2019 or the **12 month payment plan:** May, 2018 to April, 2019 (**tuition payments must be made in June and July, 2018**). Tuition must be paid in full by April 5, 2019.

PREPAID DISCOUNT: You receive a discount of 5% off tuition if it is paid in full **by August 21, 2018.**

ADMISSION EVALUATION: A developmental evaluation is given to new students entering kindergarten and first grade. An achievement evaluation may be administered to new students entering second through six grades.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is available for students enrolled in Kindergarten-Grade 6 whose families qualify based on financial need. Information and applications are available in the school office.

OTHER PROGRAMS AND FEES: Information is issued at a later date regarding the following:

- Hot lunch program
- After Care Programs
- Lunch drink – milk program (paid by the semester or year)
- Birthday books donated to the library (purchased through the library) and Book Fair
- Fundraisers such as T-shirts, Annual Giving Campaign, Annual Auction, and Pumpkin Patch
- Field trip fees
- Class supply list and other supplies needed throughout the school year

WAITING LIST: When a class is filled to maximum capacity, a numbered waiting list is created. When the list increases for a certain class, an additional class of the same grade will be opened.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND A SUMMARY OF REGISTRATION REQUIRMENTS: Parents must provide a copy of the child’s birth certificate, immunization record, previous school records, and documents of custody arrangements, if applicable.
