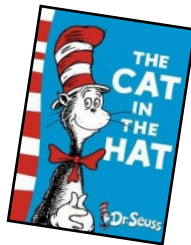

## Stay Home, Stay Safe

On March 29, 2020, **County Judge Greg Sowell** and **Mayor Shelley Brophy** sent out "Nacogdoches City and County Issue Stay Home, Stay Safe Orders" to last until April 7, 2020, at 12:59 pm, or until the declaration is either rescinded, superseded, or amended. That evening, **President Donald Trump** declared that the nation follow social distancing guidelines through April 30, 2020. On March 31, 2020, **Texas Governor Greg Abbott** issued an "Executive Order" for Texas schools to remain closed and dependent on distance learning until **May 4, 2020.**

Weekly packet pickups will continue on **Thursdays** unless other declarations are made.

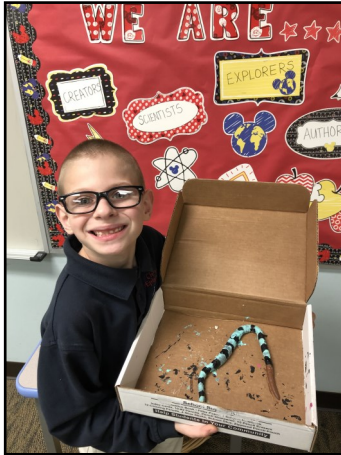

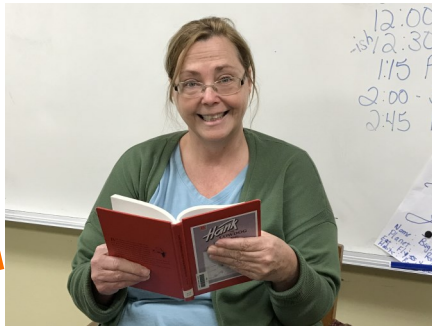
## Discovery Fridays!
