We sold \$15,901. 50 in pumpkins which gave us a 33.3% profit of \$5,595.20. Additional funds of \$5,264.16 collected from straight donations and the sales after the contract ended increased our profit greatly. Our expenses were \$231. With the Pumpkin Patch t-shirts profit of \$503, the grand total raised was **\$11,131.36**. Thank you to **Jay and Jaime Anderson**, our
