MEMBERS OF CHRIST CHURCH: Communicants in good standing of Christ Episcopal Church will receive a \$300.00 discount from the yearly tuition of one child. The discount is deducted from the child's last tuition payment in April, 2022.

FAMILIES WITH 2 OR MORE STUDENTS REGISTERED: The second sibling discount is \$300 off the yearly tuition. The discount is deducted from the second child's last tuition payment in April, 2022.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: The non-refundable Registration Fee is due upon enrollment. **The first tuition payment is due by May 5, 2021. This payment is not refundable after June 1, 2021.** Monthly tuition payments are due **on or before the fifth** day of each month from August, 2021 through April, 2022. A **\$10.00 late fee** is charged after the **tenth** of the month.

PAYMENT PLANS: You may choose the 10 month payment plan: May, 2021 and August, 2021 to April, 2022 or the **12 month payment plan:** May, 2021 to April, 2022 (**tuition payments must be made in June and July, 2021**). Tuition must be paid in full by April 5, 2022.

PREPAID DISCOUNT: You receive a discount of 5% off tuition if it is paid in full **by August 20, 2021.**

ADMISSION EVALUATION: A developmental evaluation is given to new students entering kindergarten and first grade. An achievement evaluation may be administered to new students entering second through fifth grades.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is available for students enrolled in Kindergarten-Grade 5 whose families qualify based on financial need. Information and applications are available in the school office.

OTHER PROGRAMS AND FEES: Information is issued at a later date regarding the following:

- Hot lunch program
- Extended Day Programs
- Book Fair
- Fundraisers such as T-shirts, Annual Giving Campaign, Annual Auction, and Pumpkin Patch
- Field trip fees
- Class supply list and other supplies needed throughout the school year

WAITING LIST: When a class is filled to maximum capacity, a numbered waiting list is created.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND A SUMMARY OF REGISTRATION REQUIRMENTS: **New student's** parents must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate, immunization record, previous school records, and documents of custody arrangements, if applicable.
